

National educational seminar Hammersmith Infant Neurological Examination (HINE)

19-20th of January in Stockholm, Sweden

Topic: This 2-day educational seminar provides an introduction to the Hammersmith Infant Neurological Examination (HINE) in young infants. Compelling evidence has shown that using this assessment method at early age, in combination with other well established assessment methods such as Magnetic Resonance Imaging and General Movement Assessment, is a strong predictor for later adverse motor development in high-risk infants. The HINE is today strongly recommended as a standard assessment in the National neonatal follow-up program in Sweden.
